To run shelter homes for disabled, leprosy patients, aged and children.

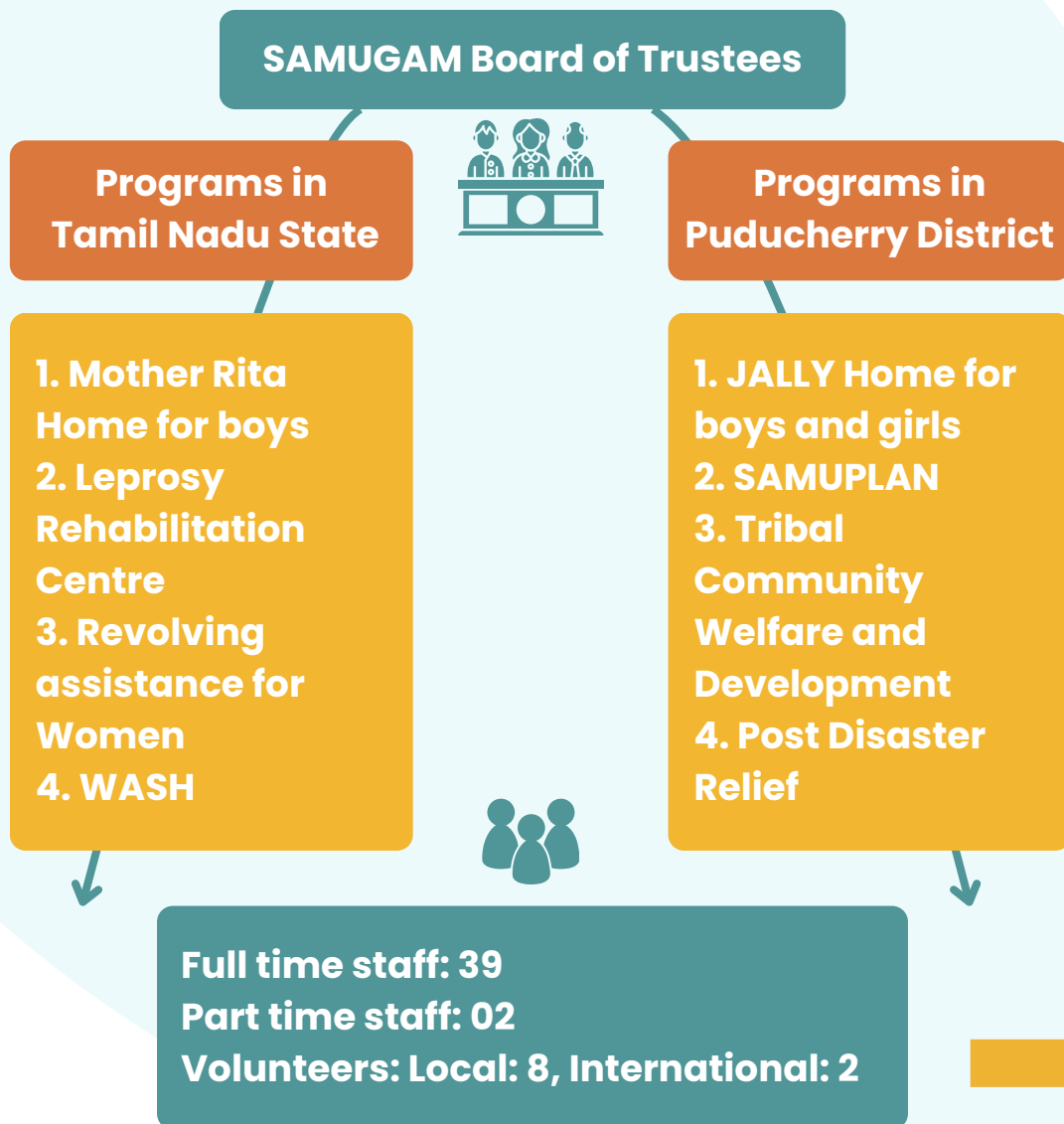
